

The **Install** button installs the extension, the **Uninstall** button uninstalls it. Technically, installation downloads the .wdl file corresponding to the extension, and installs it in the user's Appdata directory (C:\Users\[windows user]\AppData\Roaming\GESTAN15\).

To update an extension, uninstall it using the **Uninstall** button, then reinstall it.

On the library list screen, the **Act/Dsct** button enables you to activate, or not, the library for the current Gestan database, for each user. You can also double-click on the column.

 Port 3306 must be available for Gestan to query the MySQL database containing the list of available extensions.

Installing an extension causes :

- a sub-menu may be added to the **Business** menu in Gestan's main menu;
- a sub-menu may be added to one of Gestan's existing menus;
- the possible addition of a settings menu in the Tools → Application settings→Extensions settings menu.



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
